Point to GYM TEACHER. I see a gym teacher (or P.E. teacher or local term).

TASK:

Point to PICTURE. What are some students doing? PAUSE.

If student verbally responds:


Point to BLANK LINES. **Now write** (student response) **here.** PAUSE.

If meets, go to **MOVING ON** box.

If approaches or no response, continue.

Q1 EXPECT

The student writes a single word.

QUESTION 2

MODEL TASK FOR STUDENT:

Point to PICTURE: These students are running.

Point to BLANK LINES: Running. I will write "running" here. Write "running."

TASK:

Now it's your turn.

Point to BLANK LINES. Write "running" here. PAUSE.

If meets, go to **MOVING ON** box.

If approaches or no response, continue.

Q2 EXPECT

The student writes a single word.

QUESTION 3

Point to BALL. The students are throwing a ball. PAUSE.

Point to BALL. Ball. B-A-L-L. Ball.

If student responds:

Point to BLANK LINES. Now you write the word "ball" here. PAUSE.

Go to **MOVING ON** box.

Q3 EXPECT

The student writes 1 single representation of something (e.g., number, letter, symbol).

MOVING ON
