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Scaffolding Learning through Language

Audience: This workshop is designed for all educators of multilingual learners. It provides a great opportunity for teams who work with the same language learners to collaborate.

Description: This two-day workshop provides educators with a fresh look at how to engage multilingual learners in rigorous content area learning with a balance of challenge and support. The purpose of the workshop is to encourage educators to consider a dynamic set of classroom practices that support multilingual students as they move toward increasing independence and expertise in grade-level content. Participants will explore how rigorous and well-sequenced curriculum—within the content of meaningful experiences—contributes to rich classroom interactions that mediate learning. Topics that educators will explore are a) valuing students' resources for learning, b) developing a strong community of learners, and c) engaging students in rigorous curriculum.

Participants will be able to:

- Develop an understanding of scaffolding practices based on prior knowledge, new learning, and shared experience
- Build awareness of macro- and micro-scaffolding practices that apprentice students into language use for content area learning
- Consider how students' resources can support collaborative learning
- Recognize the importance of establishing a collaborative community of learners that moves forward and upward together
- Examine ways to engage students in exploring language use for content learning

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Bringing Language into Focus: Expectations, Functions and Features

Two 90-minute webinars + Online Self-Paced Module
Dates: October 29, 2024 and November 19, 2024
Time: 3:30 - 5:00pm ET

Audience: Designed for K-12 educators and focuses on intentional language instruction in the classroom using the WIDA English Language Development Standards Framework (2020 edition).

Description: This workshop gives K-12 educators an opportunity to take a closer look at the Key Language Uses (genre families) by engaging in a deeper exploration of Language Expectations, Language Functions, and Language Features. Participants will learn the importance and purpose of mentor text to make language visible to students. Participants will engage in exploration of materials and additional resources to support their classroom implementation.

By the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Identify Language Expectations: Language Functions and Language Features aligned to a Key Language Use in a content unit
- Connect the linguistic resources students bring to this learning context
- Leverage Language Functions and Language Features with students in instructional practice

When Language and Disability Meet: Planning Instruction to Support Dually Identified Students

Two 90-Minute Webinars + Online Resources

Audience: This workshop is designed for any educator who supports dually identified students: students who are multilingual learners who have been identified as needing both English language development and special education services.

Description: In this workshop, participants will learn about the principles of Universal Design for Learning alongside instructional planning considerations from the WIDA English Language Development Standards Framework, 2020 Edition. Participants will explore specific considerations for instruction that support both language development and accessibility. Participants will also examine how collaborative conversations can be framed around student intersections of language and disability to facilitate the communication of information that positively impacts the decisions educators make for instructional planning.

- Build awareness of macro- and micro-scaffolding practices that apprentice students into language use for content area learning.
 - Consider how students' resources can support collaborative learning.
 - Recognize the importance of establishing a collaborative community of learners that moves forward and upward together.
 - Examine ways to engage students in exploring language use for content learning.
- Develop a vision for Scaffolding UP in your context.
