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





1. ACCESS Data Validation Windows and Participation Requirements

2025 ACCESS for ELLs: Important Dates

Test Window	January 6, 2025 – February 28, 2025
Deadline to return materials to DRC	February 28, 2025
Pre-Reporting data validation in AMS	March 24 – March 28, 2025
ACCESS Reports and Data Files Available in AMS	April 28, 2025
ACCESS Reports Available in Schools (Paper)	May 14, 2025
Post-Reporting Data Validation in AMS	May 14, 2025 – May 22, 2025
Updated ACCESS Data Available in AMS	June 6, 2025



Participation Requirements

- Students in K-12 must take ACCESS for ELLs if they:
 - were reported as EL in the October 2024 SIMS, OR
 - arrived after October 2024 SIMS and will be reported as EL in the March 2025 SIMS
- Students should be considered for WIDA Alternate ACCESS if they:
 - Meet the above criteria and the criteria found in the "Participation Guidelines for WIDA Alternate ACCESS 2024-2025"
- Students are not required to take ACCESS for ELLs if they are:
 - reported as EL in October 2024 SIMS, but exited EL status before testing began (i.e., before January 6, 2025), OR
 - Were enrolled and identified as EL after February 7, 2025

Students who were not tested but were required to be tested should have ABS selected in the Do Not Score section for domains not tested.



Participation Exemptions

English learners meeting the following criteria are <u>not</u> required to test in specific domains:

- Sensory: Hard of Hearing or Deaf: <u>Listening</u> and/or <u>Speaking</u> not required
- Sensory: Vision Impairment or Blind: Speaking not required when taking braille test; Speaking, Listening and Reading not required if not taking braille test.
- Nonverbal (or selectively mute) and does not use AAC device: Speaking not required
- Receives "special access" read-aloud accommodation on MCAS ELA: Reading not required (must have SA1.1 or SA1.2 in IEP).

Students can be exempted from up to two domains and receive an overall assigned score in August.

Students with the above exemptions should have SPD selected in the Do Not Score section for domains not taken.






