1. N. Seoul Tower

2. Bukchon Hanok Village

The area of Bukchon, which means the “North Village” is so named because it is located north of the stream Cheonggyecheon and Jongno. The area contains hanok (traditional korean architecture) that date to the early 20th century

3. Changdeokgung

Changdeokgung is set set within a large park in Jongno District.

Changdeokgung is also one of the Five Big Palaces, built by the kings of the Joseon dynasty.
